STEP 3:

Choose your pathway:

Construction 1

Designed for students attending HSE/GED® classes or for those with a High School diploma working to increase Math and Reading scores to apply for Construction.

Construction 2

Highway Construction Careers Training Program: Prepares students for careers in local Union Construction Trades (must meet eligibility requirements).

Information Technology (IT)

One semester Comp TIA A+ coursework created to educate students about IT opportunities at L&C and careers in the industry.

Health Sciences

Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)

Bridge to Warehousing

Eight-week session that prepares students to transition into Truck Driver Training (CDL) or directly to work in Warehousing.

English as a Second Language (ESL) High School Equivalency Instruction

Prepares students to pass their GED®, Hi-Set, or TASK.

I-Pathways

Online GED instruction.

Family Literacy

Parents with at least one child under 16 years old can participate in parent/child activities while earning their HSE/GED®.

Project Read

Tutoring program for prospective learners looking to improve their Math/Reading skills, further their education, or enter the workforce.

YouthBuild

Program designed for 16-24 year old students that are completing their HSE/GED® while doing workforce training, career development, and leadership.

AmeriCorps

Students provide 450 hours of service to the community and earn an Education Award that can be used to pay for college or training.
